

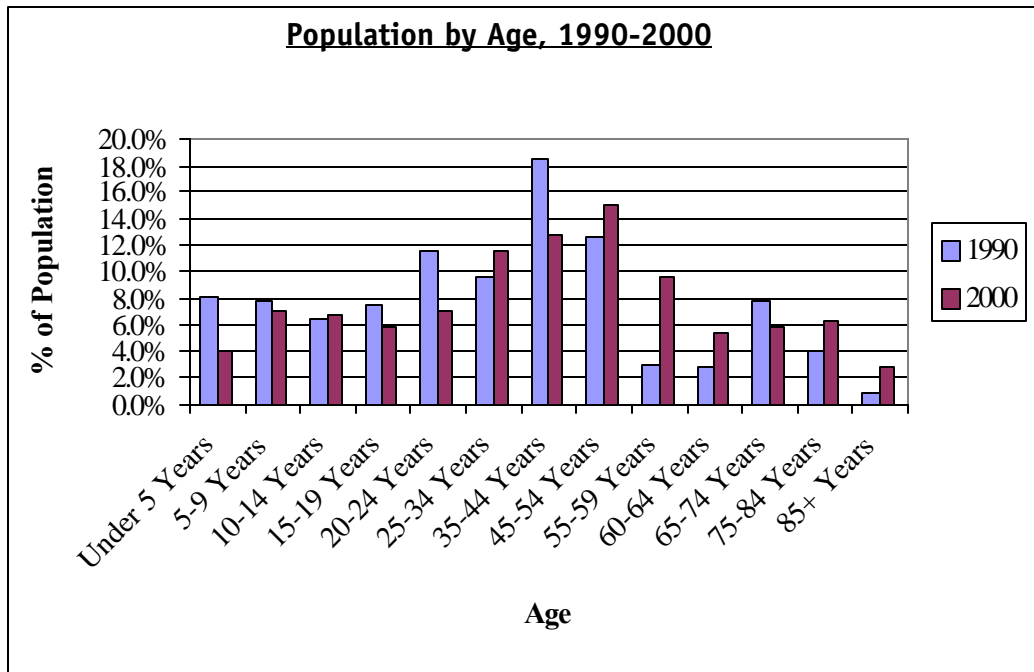

The population of the Town of Bonneau decreased by a little over 5 percent during the 1990's. The number of children under the age of 9 years also decreased, by almost 34 percent, while the number of residents over the age of 65 increased by almost 13 percent.

Other age brackets that experienced significant decreases in population included the 15 to 19 years, 20 to 24 years, 35 to 44 years, and 65 to 74 years age categories.

During the 1990's, the number of persons living in households decreased by 5.3 percent, while the number of households increased by more than 18 percent. However, the number of married couple households and children in households declined substantially. The number of other relatives and nonrelatives in households increased, as did the number of female householders with no husband present, nonfamily households, and householders living alone.

Both the average household and average family sizes decreased significantly, as did the number of persons per owner and renter occupied units.
