

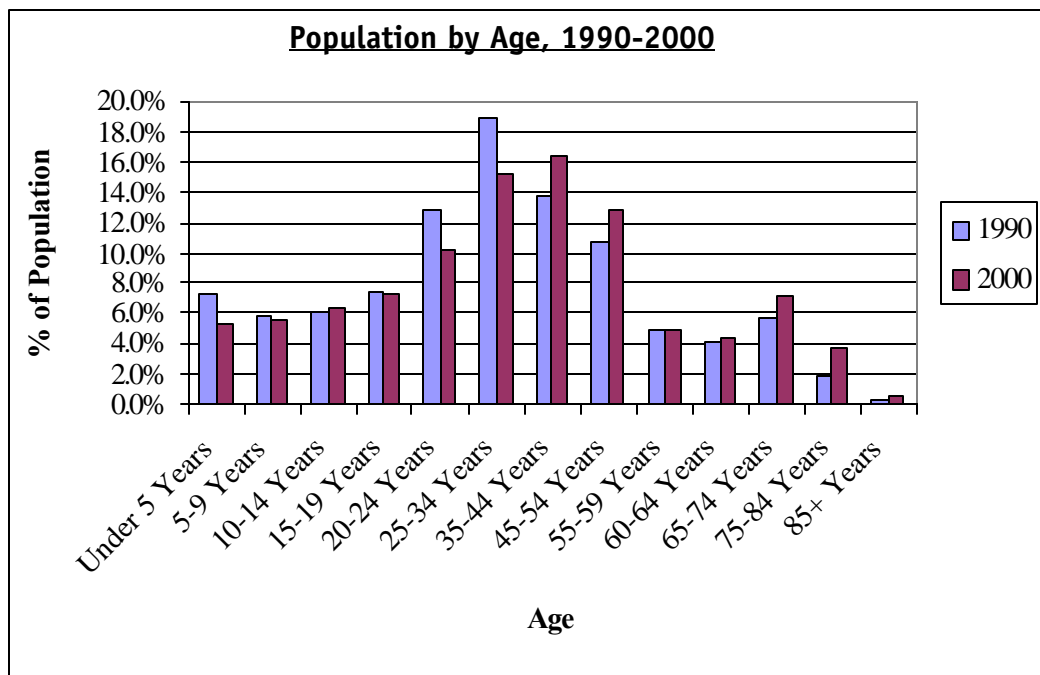

The population of the City of Hanahan decreased by just under 2 percent between 1990 and 2000. The female population of the City decreased, as well, by more than 4 percent. The City lost almost 20 percent of its children under the age of 9 during the 1990's, but gained more than 43 percent more residents 65 years or older. Other age brackets where population loss occurred included the age groups between 15 and 34 years as well as the 55 to 59 years age category.

The median age increased from 29.8 years in 1990 to 35 years in 2000, an increase of 5.2 years.

The household composition of the City of Hanahan changed as the number of married couple households and the number of children in households decreased by 17.2 percent and 18.9 percent, respectively. The total number of households and family households also declined. Increases were seen in the number of other relatives and nonrelatives in households, and the number of unmarried partner households. The number of female householders with no husband present, nonfamily households, and householders living alone also increased.

The average household size decreased by almost 9 percent, while the average family size decreased by almost 5 percent. The number of persons per owner and renter occupied units also decreased.
