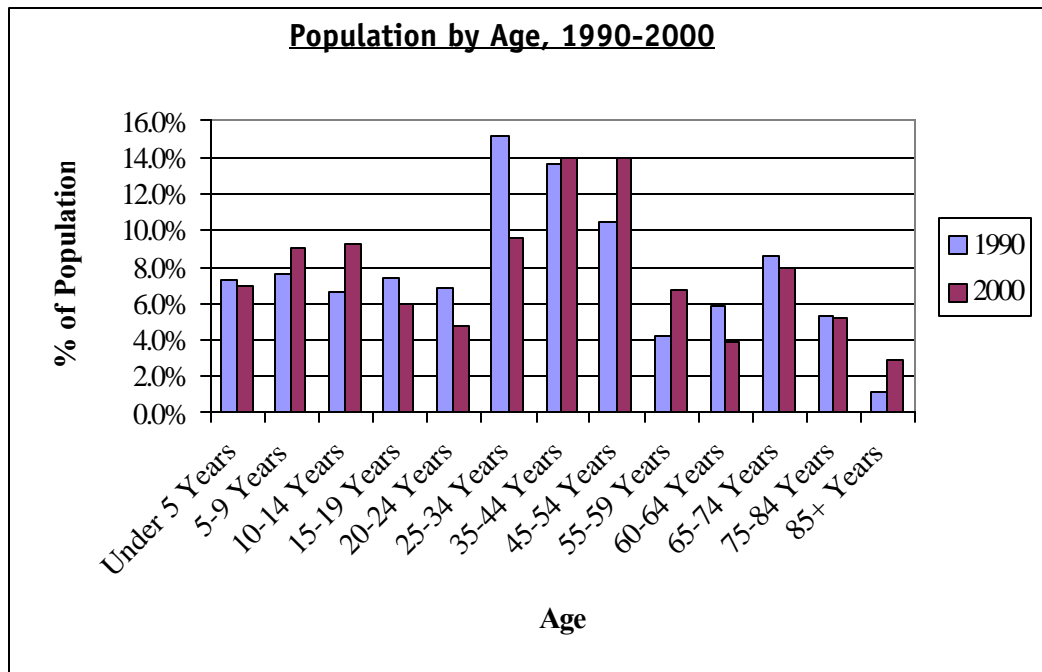

The Town of Harleyville experienced a decrease in population during the 1990's of over 6 percent. Both the male and female populations declined, although the male population dropped at a higher rate. The number of children under the age of 5 also decreased, by almost 11 percent. However, the number of residents over the age of 65 remained the same as in 1990.

The number of households in the Town of Harleyville declined during the 1990's, as did the number of married family households. The number of children in households decreased over 11 percent, while the average household and family sizes declined by 2.5 percent and 2 percent, respectively.

The household composition of the Town shifted over the last decade as the number of other relatives and nonrelatives in households increased significantly. The number of female householders with no husband present and nonfamily households increased by 12.2 percent and 4.9 percent, respectively.
