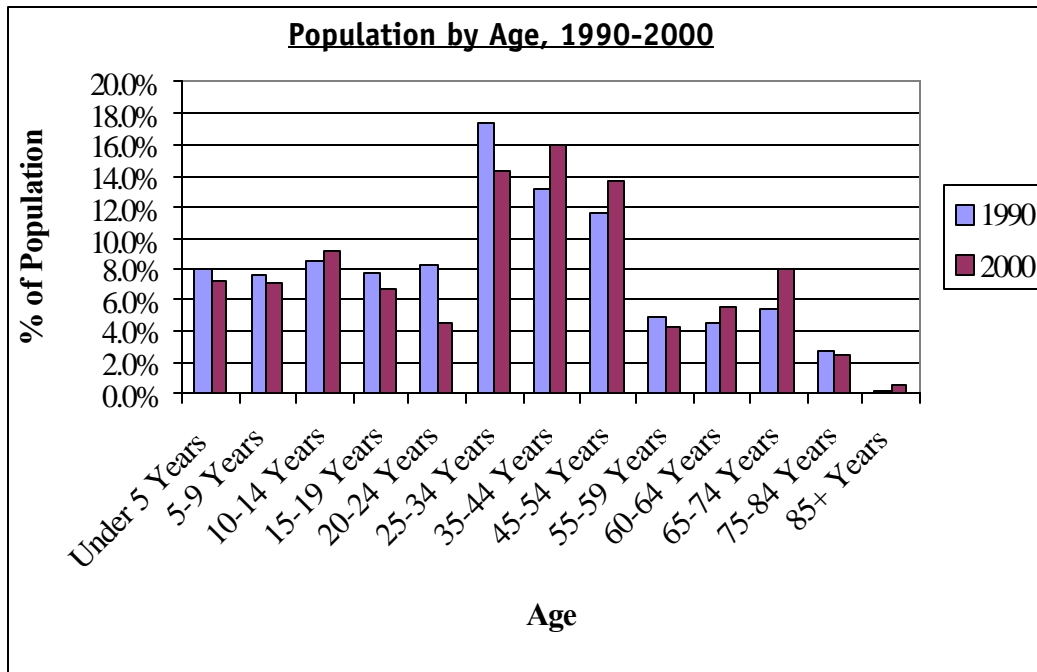

The Town of Lincolnville's population increased by more than 26 percent between 1990 and 2000. The female population increased at a higher rate than did the male population, although the male population remained the majority of the population in 2000. The population of children under the age of 18 increased by almost 26 percent. The population of residents over the age of 65 increased at a much higher rate than that of the 18 years and older population.

The major changes in the household composition of the Town of Lincolnville included the decreases in the number of own children under the age of 18 in households and the average household and family sizes. The number of other relatives and nonrelatives in households both increased by large amounts.

The number of female householders with no husband present increased by more than 71 percent, while the number of nonfamily households increased by more than 51 percent. The number of householders living alone increased by more than 42 percent.
