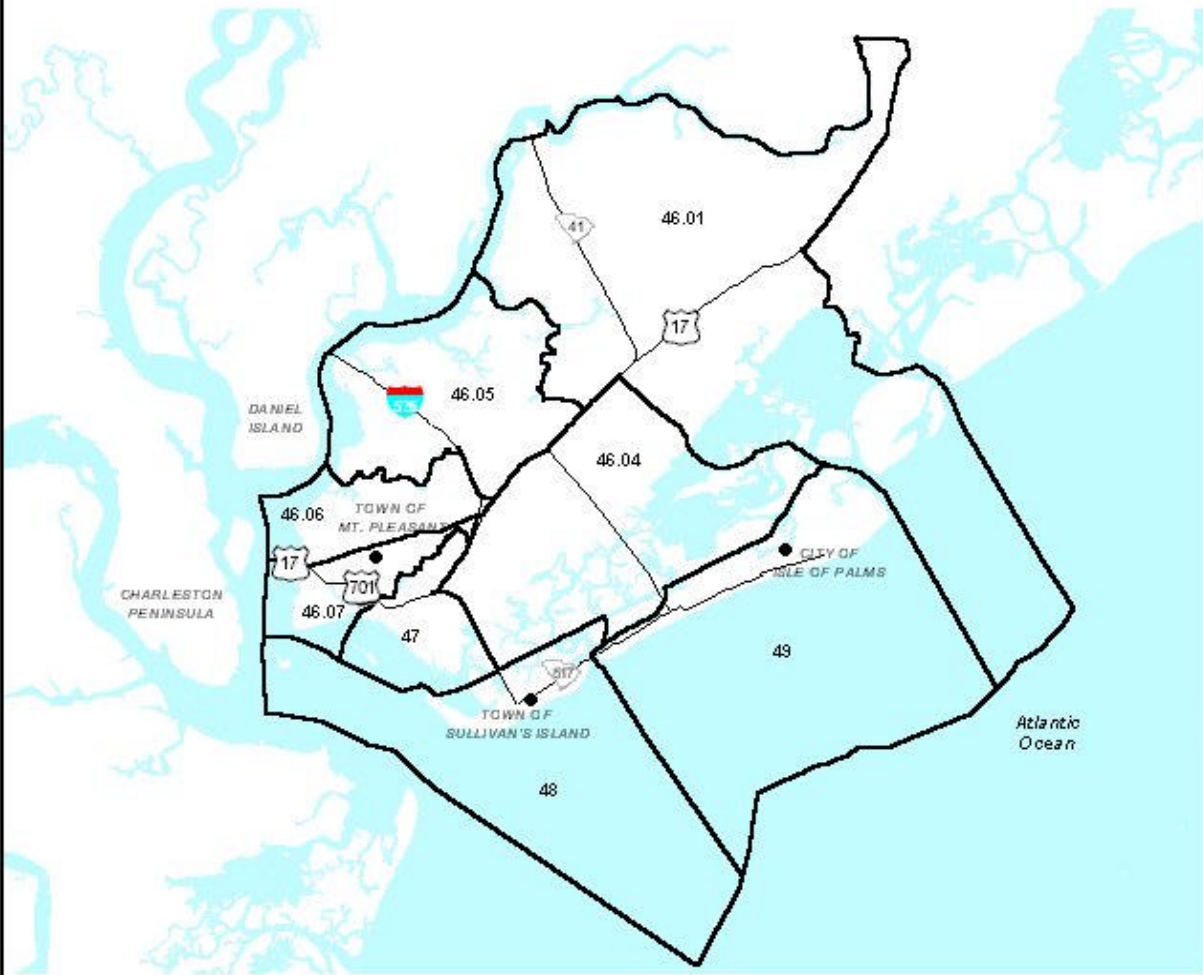





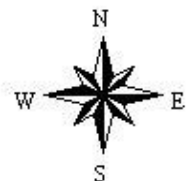


# Map 8: East Cooper Planning Area

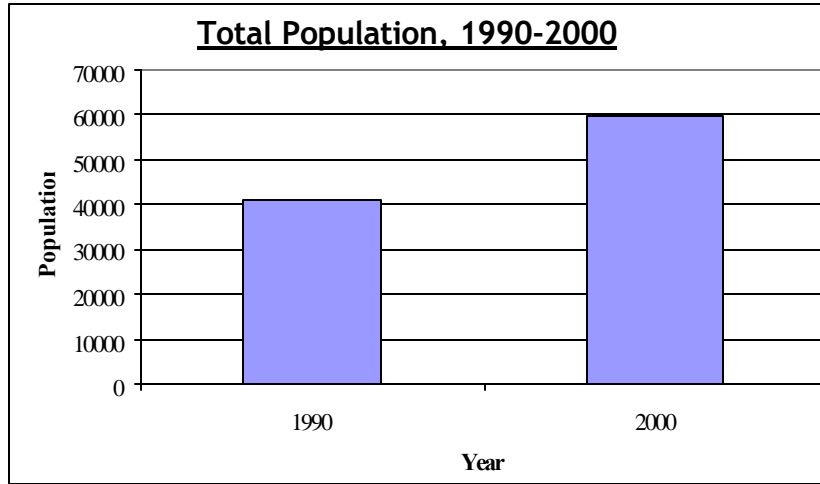

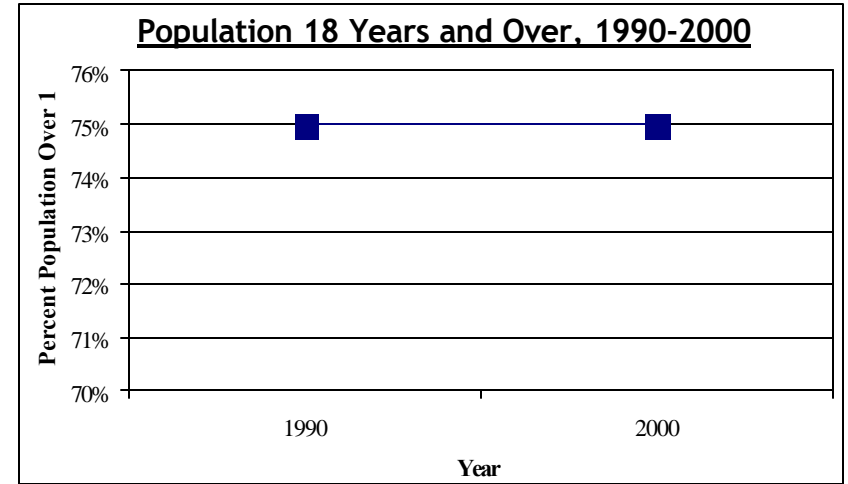

# East Cooper



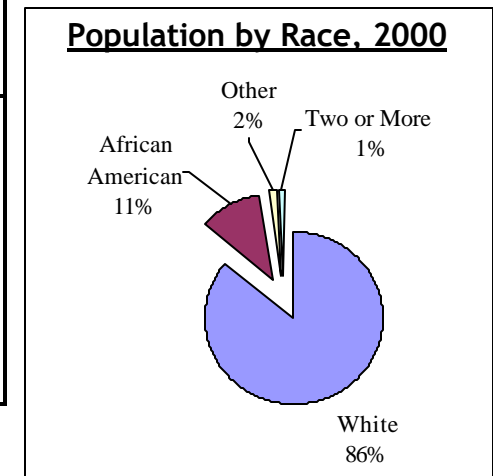
The population of the East Cooper Planning Area increased more than any other planning area in the County between 1990 and 2000. The population increased by more than 18,000 residents, or 45 percent.



The percent of the population over the age of 18 remained at 75 percent during the 1990's. However, there was an increase of almost 14,000 persons, or 45 percent, over the age of 18 during the 1990's.
