




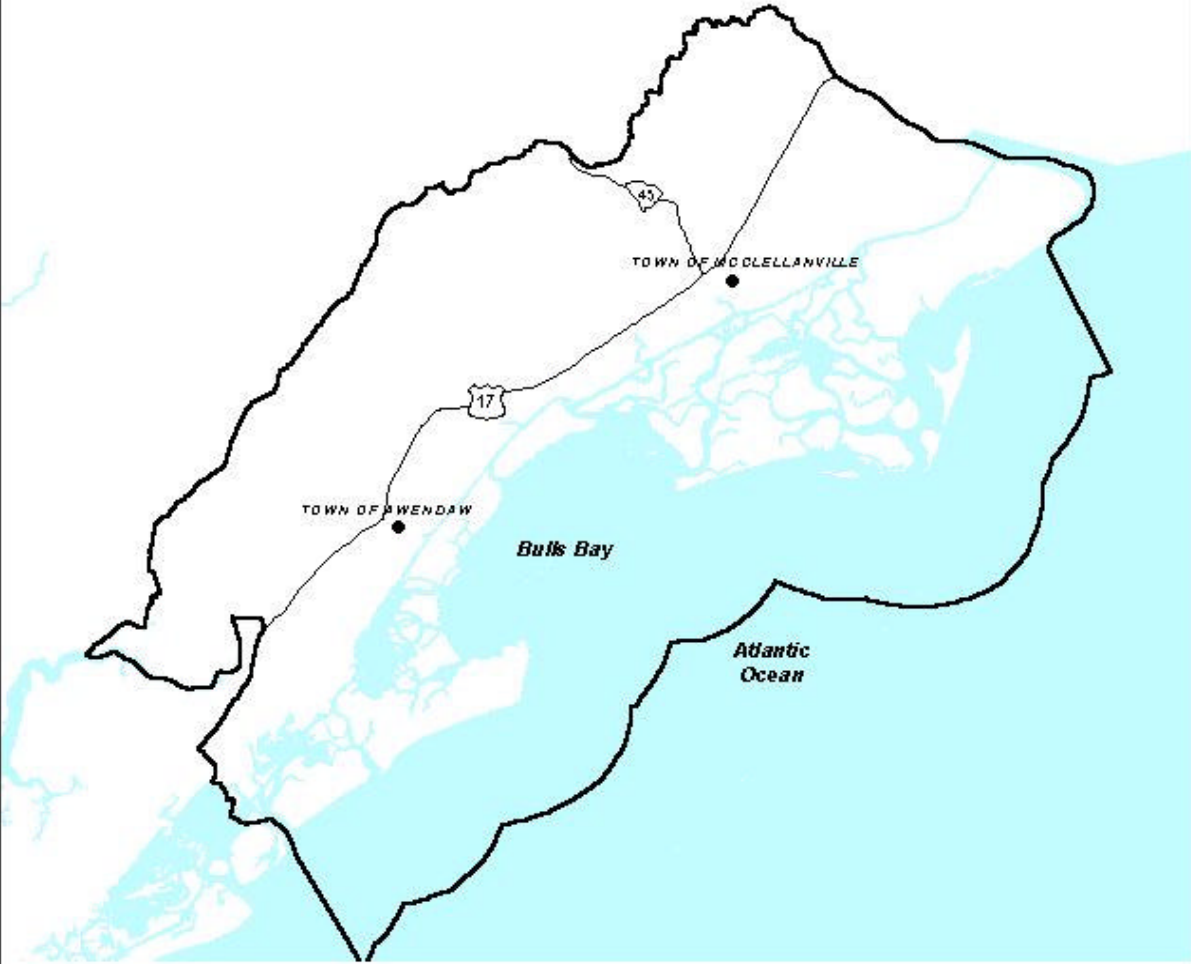


# Map 9: East County Planning Area

## LEGEND

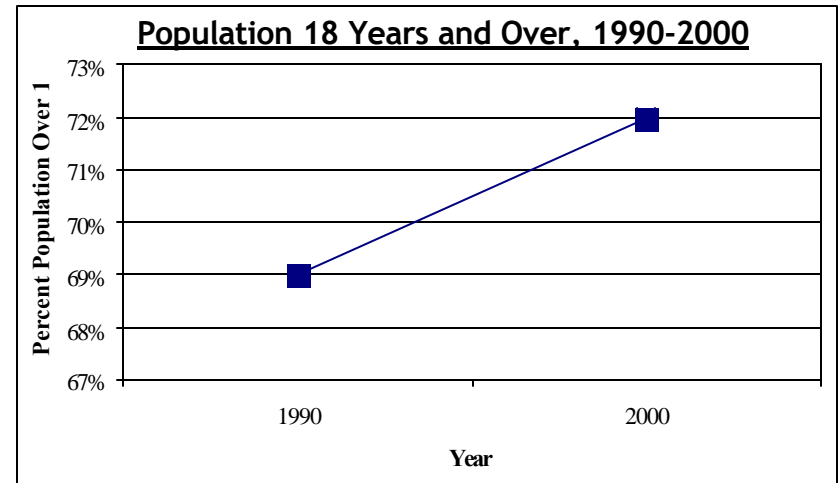
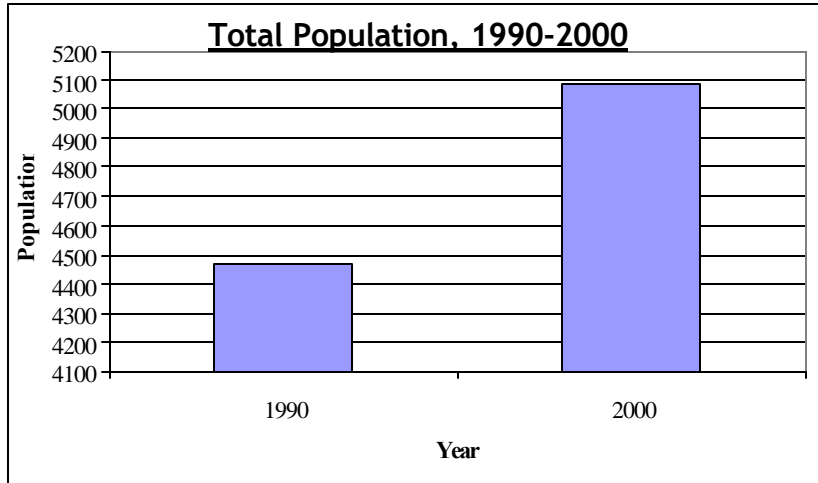
-  Water Resources

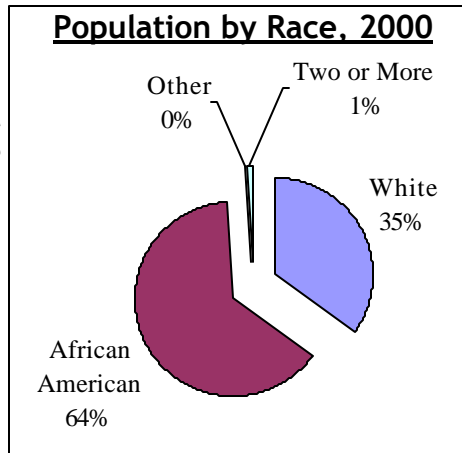
### Locator Map



# East County



The population of the East County Planning Area increased by 626 people, or 14 percent, during the 1990's. With a 2000 population of just over 5,000, East County had the smallest population of all the planning areas in the County.



The percent of population over 18 years of age increased from 69 percent to 72 percent between 1990 and 2000. Overall, the population over 18 years of age increased by almost 19 percent during the 1990's.

The White population increased by almost 37 percent during the 1990's, while that of the African American population only increased by 3 percent. In 1990, the proportion of White residents to African American residents was 29 percent to 71 percent, respectively. By 2000, that proportion shifted to 35 percent White and 64 percent African American. The "Other" population increased by 283 percent during the 1990's, increasing from 6 persons in 1990 to 23 persons in 2000.
