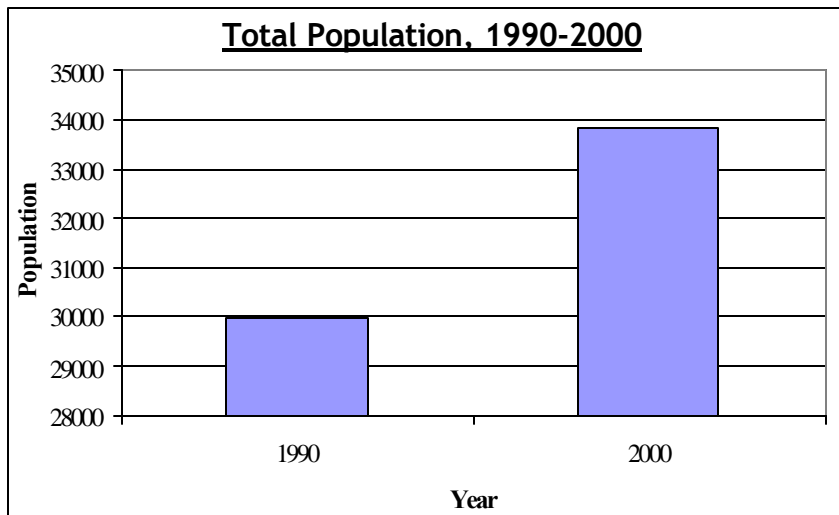

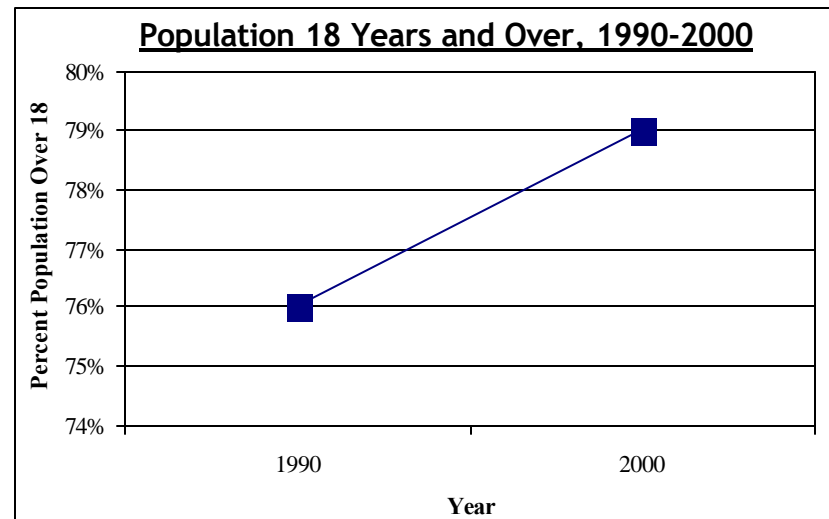

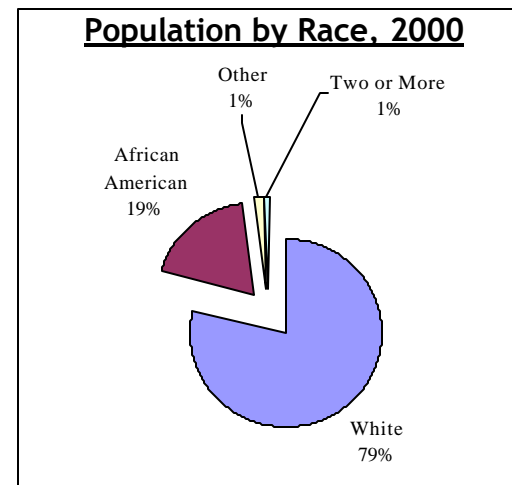
The population of the James Island Planning Area had one of the largest percent increases in population during the 1990's. The area gained 3,902 people, an increase of 13 percent, bringing the total population of the area up to almost 34,000 people.



The population of persons 18 years and older increased by more than 18 percent between 1990 and 2000. Currently, 79 percent of the population is over 18 years of age.
