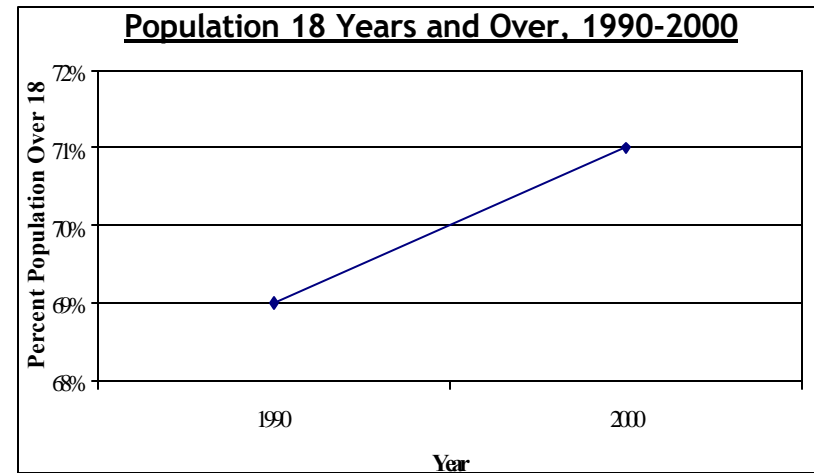
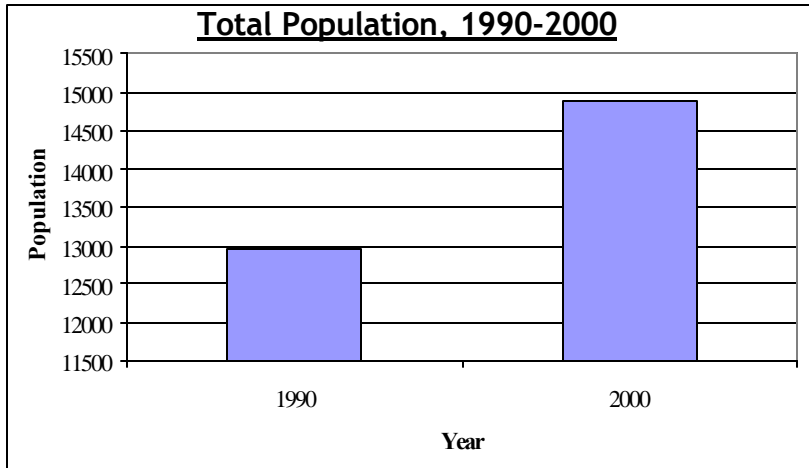
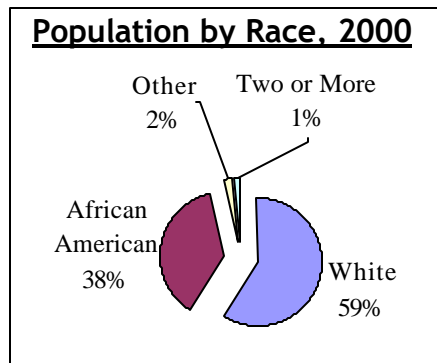


# Moncks Corner



Due to an influx of almost 2,000 residents, the population of the Moncks Corner Planning Area increased by 15 percent during the 1990's. Almost 11 percent of the County-wide population lived in the Moncks Corner area in 2000.



More than 69 percent of the population was 18 years or older in 1990. In 2000, 71 percent of the population was over 18, an increase of 19 percent in the total number of persons over the age of 18.

Between 1990 and 2000, the African American population increased by almost 24 percent while the White population increased at a much slower rate, 5 percent. The "Other" population rose by 329 percent, going from 86 persons in 1990 to 369 persons in 2000.
